**Presentasjon av Dommer Rasespesial 2026**

My first experience of looking after a Show Dog was when I attended College I had a week-end job as kennel maid at the World famous 'Bergerie' Pyrenean Mountain Dog Kennel in August 1970. 'Bergerie Knur' had won BIS at CRUFTS in February 1970. I caught the bug for exhibiting dogs when I handled a Pyrenean puppy at a Club show and gained Best Puppy in Show, the judge was Bill Siggers. I bought my first Lhasa Apso in 1973 and my first show dog (Viento April Love) was owned in partnership with Rosemary and Frank Wallis (Viento Lhasa Apsos). I handled Rosemary and Frank's champions for them, including Ch Wyrley Hermes who I handled to Res C.C. at Crufts in 1976 the judge being Lady Freda Valentine. I made up my first Champion in 1987 (Ch Viento Love in a Mist bred and owned in partnership with Rosemary Wallis).

In 1984 I judged the Lhasa Apso Club Open Show. I judged my first Championship show in 1987, this being Southern Counties Championship Show, this was followed by judging my first Club Championship show in April 1989 being the Midland Lhasa Apso Association. In May of that year I was able to attend the American Lhasa Apso Club 30th Anniversary Speciality Show and seminar in Washington DC, the judge for this show was Mrs Francis Sefton (Cheska). In 1995 I was asked to write the breed notes for 'Dog World' and wrote weekly until 2017 when the paper went into administration. In 1996 I became Secretary of the Lhasa Apso Association of Wales and South West.

I had the honour of judging the Lhasa Apso Club Championship Show in 2000. In 2005 I was privileged to judge our delightful breed at CRUFTS. In 2006 I travelled with my husband Jack to Tibet and we went overland from Lhasa to Kathmandu via Everest base camp which was a great experience. At Crufts 2007 I won the bitch C.C. with a seven year old namely 'Sinyul Brief Encounter' this was her third and qualifying C.C. the judge being Juliette Cunliffe. I travelled to Sweden in 2008 to judge the breed at Tibethund which was very enjoyable. In 2010 I had the privilege to judge the Lhasa Apso Association of New South Wales Easter Show.

All my current Lhasa Apsos go back to my first show dog. In 1993, I bought an eight week old puppy bred by Mr Terry Poole and Mrs Sue Trollope, who was to become Ch Desperately Seeking at Sinyul (Dora), all my current show dogs go back to her also.

I have bred seven UK Lhasa Apso Champions and owned eight. I have judged Lhasa Apsos at C.C. level in the UK for 14 times and felt very privileged and honoured to judge the Bitches at Crufts in 2025, 20 years since I judged the breed at Crufts. I am very much looking forward to visiting you and judging your dogs.
